BASIC INFORMATION ON LOCATIONS

SEARCHING FOR LOCATIONS:

1. It is recommended to send an email to junta@bardenasreales.es indicating the date, the contact details of the locator as well as the registration number of the vehicle to be used, at least 72 hours in advance in order to be able to transfer the activity to the Community Ranger service.
2. The locations must be located next to the tourist routes for motorised vehicles in the Natural Park (at a maximum distance of 20 metres), although in some cases they may also be authorised next to the MTB routes (official maps can be consulted at <https://app.bardenasreales.es/rutas-por-bardenas>).
3. The landscape of Bardenas is as interesting as it is changeable, so, in order to avoid confusion, it is recommended that the search for locations be done directly on the ground and as close as possible to the dates of the work. For this reason, photographs obtained from internet databases will only be accepted in exceptional cases, as these photographs may not be correctly referenced or their appearance may have changed during the year, not coinciding with the expectations of the work team.

PROPOSAL OF LOCATIONS: They shall be sent in a single pdf document containing the following information for each location:

1. A maximum of 5 locations per day will be accepted.
2. **Georeferenced photographs**, i.e. associated with the coordinates where the locations are located, indicating the coordinate system used.
3. Detailed description of the work to be carried out at each of the locations.

No work may be carried out at any location that is not included in this application and in the corresponding authorisation.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF USE: apart from the particular guidelines that may be established for any specific location and which are detailed below, in general all filming or photographic reports of an advertising nature that are carried out in this Natural Park must comply with the following guidelines:

1. The geological formations may appear in the background of the images, but given that the textures of the soil are so fragile, any action that could damage the soil (including excessive trampling) must be especially avoided. For this reason, all persons should remain on the flat part next to the formations, avoiding stepping on their slopes and hillsides. Likewise, special care shall be taken with the existing vegetation, even with the smallest plants, avoiding any damage to them.
2. All vehicles shall remain on the sides of the main road, without approaching the formations or entering the esplanade at any time, in order to avoid marking tracks and compacting the ground.



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3. No person shall go more than twenty metres from the sections of road or highway on which work is authorised;
4. The mere fact of not respecting the protection indications that have just been made, ignoring the guidelines for the safety of people, or carrying out inappropriate behaviour for the conservation of the flora, fauna and vegetation of this protected area, could mean the immediate suspension of the work and the expulsion from the Bardenas Natural Park, without prejudice to the processing of the corresponding sanctioning proceedings.
5. In the case of being interested in the use of the DRON, the following environmental conditions must be respected:
 - **FAUNA PROTECTION:** The existence of protected fauna makes it necessary to avoid disturbance in their nesting and resting areas. For this reason, the DRON may not come within 100 metres of mountains, cliffs and ponds, nor may it fly over or enter ravines. Similarly, its pilot will abort any flight if he/she detects a bird in the filming area, to avoid damage to the bird, the DRON or the equipment it is carrying.
 - **CASTILDETIERRA:** The location of this natural monument requires special precautions, so flights made by the DRON may be made in the surrounding area, but it is NOT AUTHORISED to fly over the vertical of Castildetierra, nor to approach within 50 metres of the fairy chimney.
6. In the event that it rains during the filming days or that the ground is muddy or waterlogged due to rain, the work must be inexcusably delayed until the ground is dry. If this were the case, there would be no variation in the fees payable. Likewise, only in those cases in which inclement weather prevents the development of the activity, the refund of fees will be considered. This is not the case when, once in the Biosphere Reserve, it is considered that the shots are not valid or are not finally used.
7. It is forbidden to take pictures of military installations.
